

Method : Bonnet Low Moisture Carpet Cleaning

This method can be used on most types of carpets assuming that they are

- in good condition
- being regularly dry vacuumed
- only lightly soiled
- Spots and no stains
- ideal for maintaining carpets or traffic areas

Equipment Needed



- Vacuum
- Pressure sprayer
- Standard speed rotary machine
- Bonnet pads
- Carpet pile brush
- Bucket and wringer

Step 1

Vacuum area

Step 2

Pre spray are with following dilutions and instructions. Only pre spray small working area



Step 3

- Attach a bonnet pad to rotary machine after pre dampening the pad with product
- You then rotate with the machine side to side in swings of 1 to 2 metres. Working backwards.

● A good working area is about 10 sq metres each pad will clean about 50 sq metres

- The soil will be adsorbed onto the bonnet pad

- After 50 sq metres rinse out in your bucket and wringer For heavier soils, the pad may be pre-soaked in solution of bonnet buff then lightly squeezed in a mop wringer before use.
- After each job machine wash your bonnet pads

Step 4

Reset the original pile direction. this prevents swirls when drying

Drying times are 15 to 20 minutes. so idea for areas in use all the time
